Musashi RED Programs Teaching Assistant (TA) Recruitment

Description of RED Programs: RED Programs foster a "scientific way of looking at things" based on the "The Three Founding Principles" that have lived on at Musashi since the founding of Musashi Academy. Students will learn science, the universal system of knowledge, in English, the universal language, to acquire the intelligence and culture of a global citizen. All classes will be conducted in English, and students will learn Research, Essay writing, and Discussion (RED) on scientific themes. The program is mainly for first-year junior high school students through first-year high school students, with students from Musashi High School and Junior High School accounting for 70-80% of the students, and other students from other schools in the Tokyo area. One class will have about 25-30 students, and will be taught by a teacher and several TAs.

Period: September-November 2025, January-March 2026, April-June 2026

*There will be 20 class days per semester. It is preferable that the candidate be able to work twice a week on the designated days and times throughout the above three semesters, but working for one semester is also acceptable. May be asked to renew for the next semester or the following year.

Working days: Monday and Wednesday (For lower-level classes) or Tuesday and Thursday (For upper-level classes)

17:45-20:45 (Class time: 18:30-20:30 with a one-hour meeting before and after the class, so three hours of work per day)

*In addition to the above, you may be asked to work for the Summer Program (multiple programs from the end of July to the end of August), student selection and recruiting events, or exam proctor for the TOELF ITP.

Location: Musashi University Ekoda Campus (Address: 1-26-1, Toyotama-kami, Nerima-ku, Tokyo. Nearest station: Shin-Egota station on Toei Ōedo Line, Ekoda station on Seibu Ikebukuro Line, or Shin-Sakuradai station on Seibu Yurakucho Line)

Duties: Under the direction of the teacher, perform the following main duties

- Participation in pre- and post-class meetings
- Provide support in the implementation of activities and in-class assignments for approximately 5-6 students per group in class.
- Provide general class management support to the teacher.
- Assist in the preparation and cleanup of presentations on the last day of each semester, and provide support in teaching presentations to students.

Requirements:

- Should be able to teach students and communicate with teachers in English. Japanese proficiency is a big plus.
- Interested in teaching students between the ages of 13 and 16 in English.
- Interested in supporting others.
- Interested in working in a multinational team.
- A background in science is desirable but not required. More emphasis is placed on the fact that you like communicating with people and working with children.
